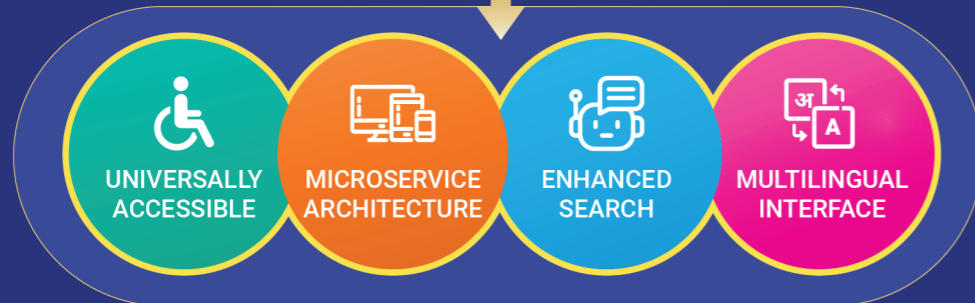
Vision
